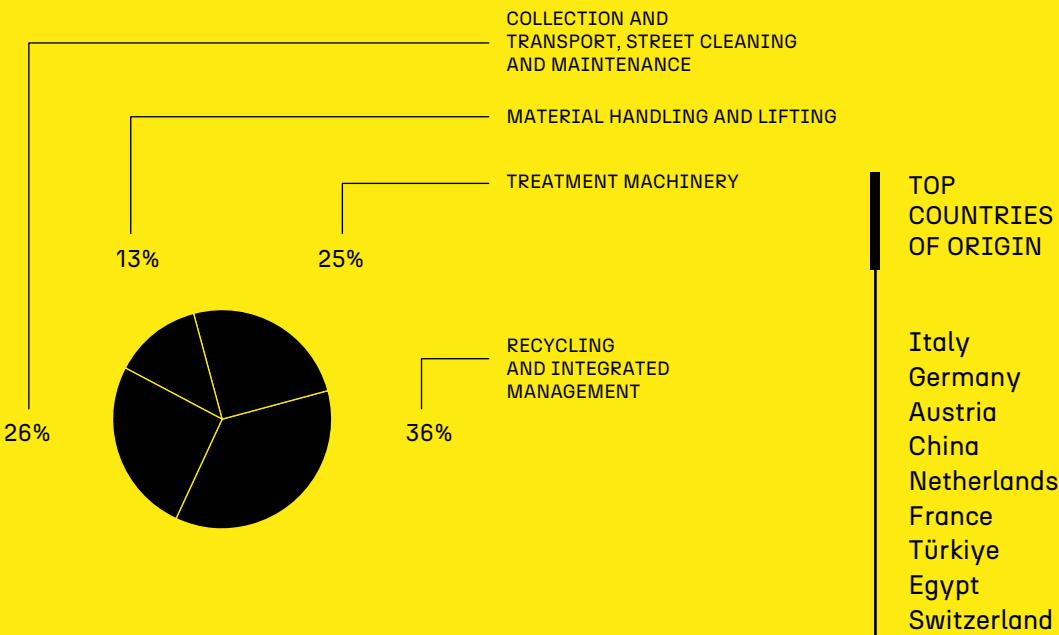

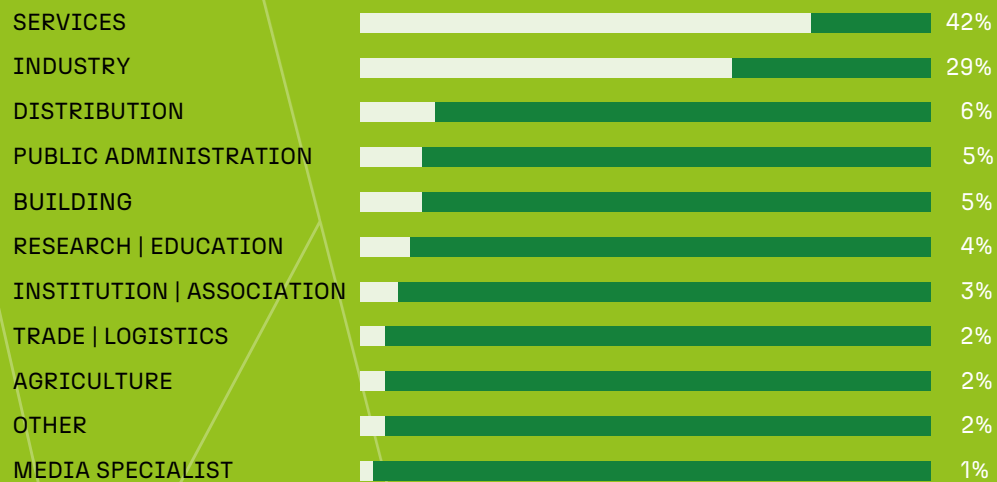

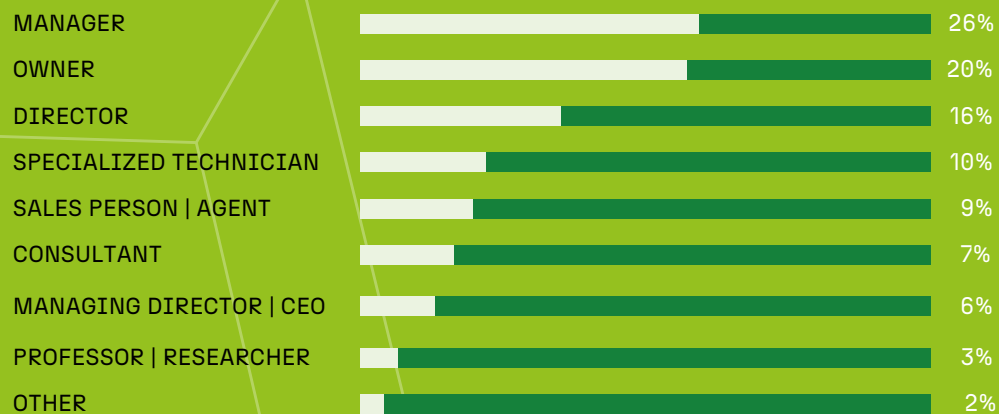

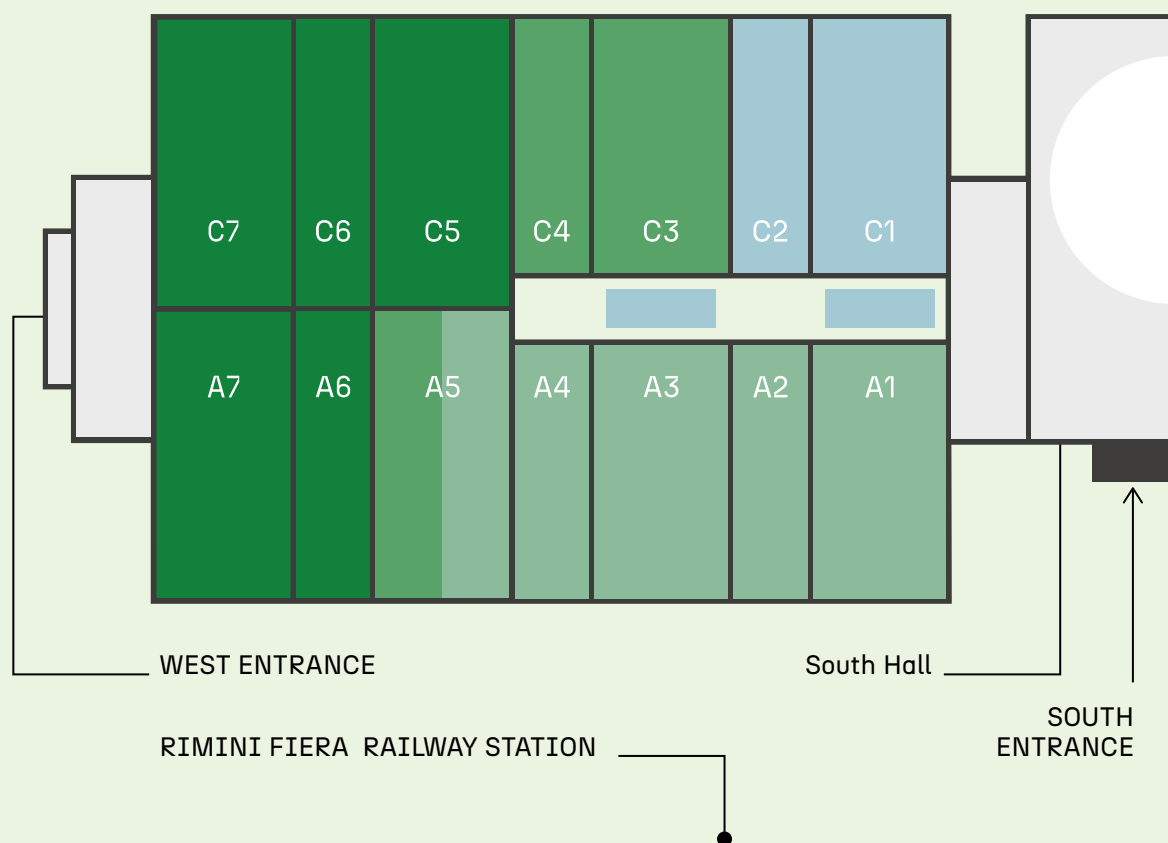

TEXTILE

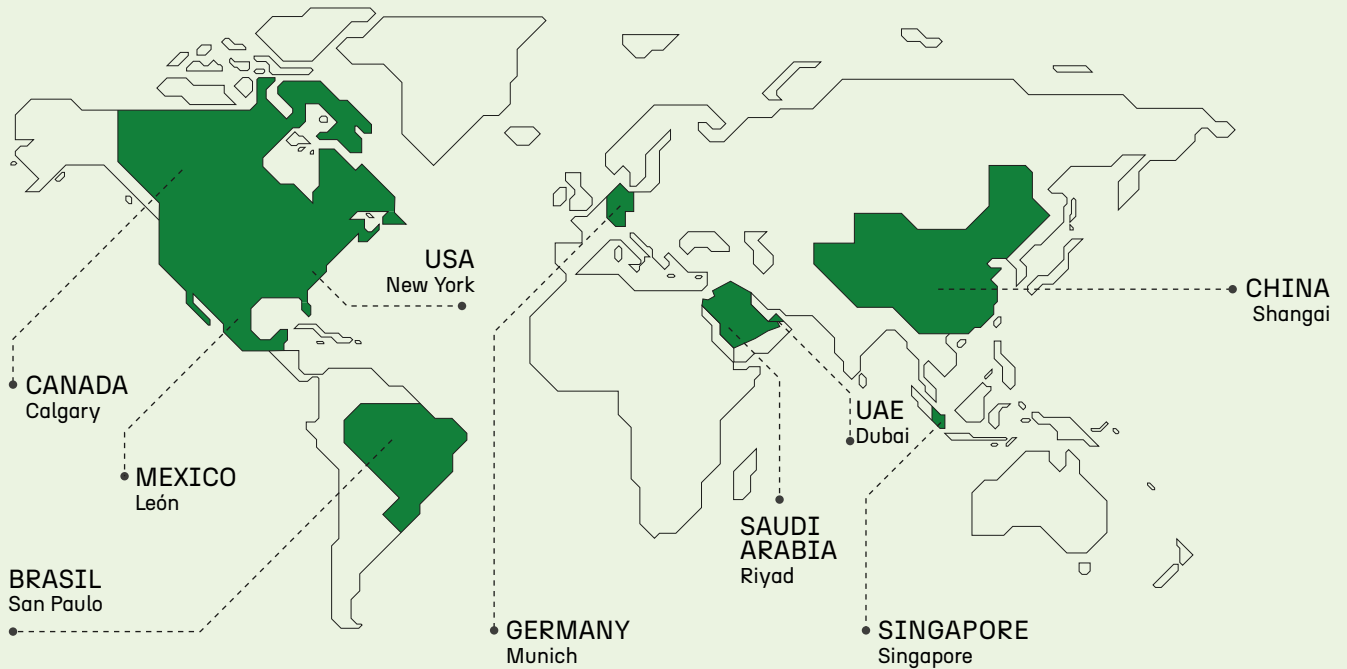
